

Guidelines for service hours:

Service hours are hours that are donated to the Church or community that are **unpaid** and **unexpected** duties. In other words, they cannot be chores at home that you would have to do normally without pay. They cannot be preplanned service work that the Confirmation program has assigned (Feed My Starving Children, Care Package night, etc.) These service activities should be completed during the Religious Education year September – April (unless preapproved for summer).
